Brookfield Place is a large office and mixed-use development in Perth, Australia.</li> <li>Tower 1 has 45 floors and is currently the second tallest building in Western Australia. BHP, the metals and mining company, is the anchor tenant, with 60,000m<sup>2</sup> of office space. Its design achieved a NABERS 5 Star Energy rating and a Green Star 5 Star rating. It completed construction in 2012.</li> <li>Tower 2 has 16 floors. It received a NABERS 4.5 Star Energy rating and a Green Star 5 Star rating. It completed construction in 2015.</li> </ul>
